Note to leaders: Think about how familiar your group members are with the story in Luke 15 we looked at and whether you need to read it together or whether you can assume that it is already well known.

Group Questions

1. Identify the various attitudes exhibited by the two sons in the story and to what extent you identify with each of them.
 2. When you've messed up how do you feel about going back to God?
 3. To what extent have you received acceptance and affirmation from your Earthly father or equivalent and how has this affected the way you view your relationship with God?
- Pray for each other probably in pairs as appropriate.

Worship suggestion

You could consider looking at Psalm 23 and thinking about God, God's fathering and shepherding of His people as part of your worship.
