“In”

The Power of the Resurrection - Mark 12: 18-27

This week we looked at how the Sadducees challenged Jesus about the resurrection of the dead. Jesus' reply, quoting from Exodus 3:2-6 (one of the books of the Bible that the same Sadducees professed to believe) proved to them that there is indeed life after we die and that God is the God of the living and not of the dead.

He accused them of two things:

1. Not knowing or understanding the scriptures and
2. Not knowing the power of God.

Questions to consider:

1. How much importance do you give to reading and studying the Word? Is it your daily bread or merely something you do when you can find the time? What decisions can you make to help you spend more time reading the word and therefore getting to know Jesus better?
2. How hungry are you to see the power of God in your life and in the lives of friends and family? Are you experiencing as much power as you would like? If not, how can you change that?

Pray for in each other in faith and expect God to manifest the power of His resurrection among you! Expect great things to happen and keep pressing in for more!
